The Question(s) Behind The Question



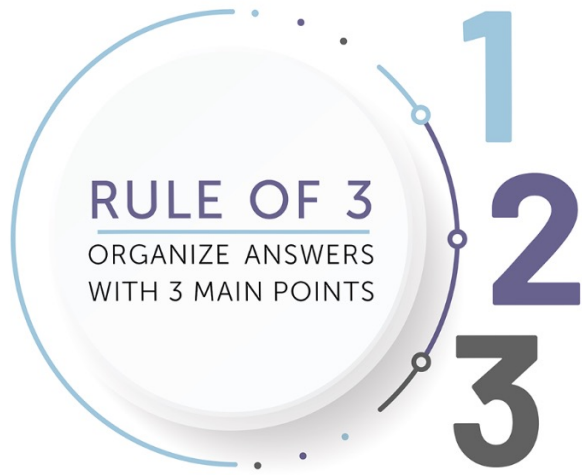
- Will you add more busywork to our plates?

- Streamline it—remove unnecessary parts

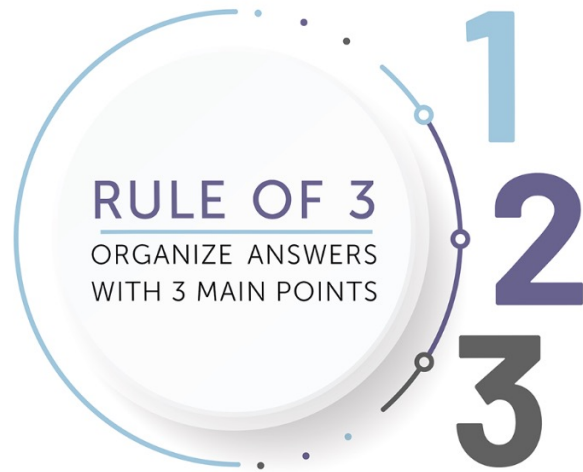
The Rule of 3—Recommendations: Curriculum Improvement
