



The Time Paradox





- Making ChatGPT produce good output requires detailed prompts
- Writing & tweaking these prompts consume as much time as ChatGPT saves you



What ChatGPT Doesn't Know (Unless You Tell It)



- Who you are or what your job & context are
- The context for a piece of input
- The intended audience for the output
- The appropriate writing style
- How much to explain/include disclaimers



How Repertoire Stores Information for ChatGPT



- System Fields—your account-level settings
- System Prompts—specific instructions we've created to tweak ChatGPT output

This information is combined with the text + images you include in the prompt



Two Scenarios for Using Repertoire with ChatGPT



- 1. Summarizing teacher observation notes
- 2. Writing a concise meeting follow-up email

Refined Templates Are Better Than ChatGPT!



Once you know what you want to say, templates are actually better for some types of writing than ChatGPT



Start with A Past Example OR ChatGPT Default Output
